1/ Subscriptions

The Committee asked if all coaches could supply squad lists and a list of players they wish to register so Jason could keep track off which players had paid, and which players were yet to pay.

2/ U8s Bank Account

The Treasurer had previously asked someone to look at the accounts he had produced for the U8s whilst the club funds were in their accounts last year. Stu has looked at the books, but still cannot find the £370 Jason had stated was the discrepancy. It was agreed to hand the accounts to Samantha Lighthowler as discussed at the AGM.

3/ Football Foundation Goalposts

Stu has received 2 sets (4 goals) of 12x6 goalposts bought with the help of a grant from the Football Foundation. Sean Byrne is to store one set and Stu the other. These goalposts were purchased to replace damaged goalposts currently stored in the changing rooms at Hills Lane.

4/ Wheatley Wanderers sign appeal

The application and the appeal for a sign to be erected at Hills Lane have both been refused by DMBC. The Committee agreed not to pursue any future interest in the sign but to look into possible taupoline signs that Jason has offered to price up. The U11s will also require one of these banners if the Committee decide to go ahead and purchase them.

5/ U11s pitch

The Current U10s, Septembers U11s, will be playing on the Intake field on Sandringham Road Intake. There are toilets available and a storage container for goalposts and equipment.

6/ Tournament

Jason submitted a list of teams that have paid for our tournament, and the Committee have asked all coaches to chase up any teams yet to pay. A gas BBQ has been offered to cook on at the tournament, and at the moment there are just a few more things to arrange. Still require teams to volunteer to run the tombola stall and help with refereeing.

7/ Stainforth Dog Track

Stu has received the invoice for 100 tickets and will purchase them shortly. Tickets will be available to anyone for £1 each.

8/ U6s

Stu and Craig informed those present that several rumours had been circulated about the U6s coach. Stu and Craig have looked into the rumours and Nathan gave the Committee his own explanation. Helen informed the Committee Nathan was well liked by all the parents and got on brilliantly with the children. The Committee saw no reasons why Nathan couldn't continue to coach the U6s. Stu to look into possibly 3 parents doing the level 1 coaching course, 1 to assist Nathan, and 2 more to run a possible 'B' team at U8 level.
