#### **1/ List of all teams entered for each age group**

A list of teams were submitted by the U10's, U6's, U9's and U7's.

#### **2/ Kick off times / turnarounds / registration times**

U6's, U8's and U9's will kick off at 10.00am playing 10 minutes straight through with a 2 minute turnaround between games. U7's and U10's will kick off at 2.00pm playing 10 minutes straight through with a 2 minute turnaround. U6's to have 2 groups of 6 and U7's, U8's, U9's and U10's to have 2 groups of 5. Registration 9.30am and 1.30pm. U6's and U7's will have squads of 8 players per team and U8's, U9's and U10's will have 10 players in the squad.

### 3/ Referees / score tent

Martin, Nathan, Craig and Alan have all offered to referee games. Looking for referees to referee the morning games (not coaches or parents of u6's, u8's or u9's) and afternoon games (not coaches or parents of u7's and u10's) Nathan might be able to get 4 lads from Rossington School to act as referees. Score tent need volunteers again from u7's and 10's to do the scoring in the morning and volunteers from u6's, u8's and u9's for the afternoon. Nathan also might be able to borrow whiteboards.

### 4/ Pitch allocation/pitch layouts

A plan of the site will need to drawn up for the setup of the pitches and for any activities that may require electricity.

### 5/ Stalls / refreshments / toilets / activities

Lots of ideas passed around i.e. bouncy castles, bouncy slides, photographers, tombolas, raffles, football cards, refreshment stands, hotdogs, burgers, bacon sandwiches. Decided on either a raffle or tombola, all refreshments to be served from one big stall so tea, coffee, crisps, pop and sweets will be under Jasons big marquee along with a possible griddle or BBQ for cooking burgers, bacon and hotdogs. Once again need volunteers from u7's and u10's for the mornings and u6's,u8's and u9's for afternoon. One adult sized bouncy castle was agreed. Portable toilets were suggested. DEphoto are unavailable on 6th July for onsite processing but might be able to send a photographer for pictures to be purchased via the internet. One football card per age group was agreed. Paul offered to cost up the meat and bread for the griddle or BBQ. Louise kindly offered her help on the stalls.

### 6/ Parking / charges / money collection / hi vis jackets

Jason has offered to help with parking on the day and has already got protective hi-vis jackets. It will be £1 for a programme with free parking. Programmes will be situated on stalls for people who walk to the tournament or arrive via another access.

### 7/ Medals / trophies

Stu to contact Vision 2000 to see what has been ordered by Troy for the tournament.

### 8/ Programme / adverts / layout / charges

As already stated the programme will cost £1. Craig has already started designing a programme and brought a copy for the everyone to view, the feedback was very positive and Craig has done a good job. Craig has received advertisements and is assessing the space left available in the programme.

### 9/ U6s Gala/teams/medals/pitch

U6's have 2 Wheatley teams and 3 other teams taking part in this years Gala. They plan to KO at 10.30am and be finished around 1.00pm. They plan to sell drinks and refreshments and possibly a raffle or tombola. All monies raised will go into WWJFC. U6's will need 50 medals purchased by the club along with their refreshments. U6's pitch will be 50x30. Nathan has asked for support on the day for the u6's and any other help would be appreciated.
