Many thanks for entering the Wheatley Wanderers JFC 2016 Summer Tournament.

The tournament is on Saturday 2nd & Sunday 3rd July 2016.

Teams are:

Saturday 2nd - Under 7's (5v5), Under 9's (7v7) & Under 15's (11v11)

Sunday 3rd - Under 6's (5v5) referred to as U7's 2016/17, Under 8's (7v7) & Under 13's (7v7)

Arrival to the ground is from 9am. We have plenty of car parking onsite. Entry cost is £2 in which you will receive a full tournament day programme. We have been asked to advise you not to park on the surrounding streets or grass verges. (Can you please pass this onto all parents attending)

Our address is Hills Lane, Wheatley Hills, Doncaster, DN2 5QA.

Registration is by 9.30am. Please complete the player registration forms and email to me or bring with you on the day. Players can only play for one team throughout the tournament and please no academy players. (In case of age disputes, players ID cards must be available or the proof of the players DOB)

Kick off is at 10am sharp. The schedule is very tight on the day so please be ready for your game.

All players will receive a tournament medal. Presentation times are in the tournament day programme.

We have available on the day burger van, bap van, ice cream van, coffee van, raffles, tombola, games and an onsite photographer.

Our aim is to bring you an enjoyable and safe tournament. We do not expect foul or abusive language from players or spectators. Coaches are advised to give all their players a fair and equal chance of playing. Coaches, parents and spectators are expected to let players play without screaming or shouting from the touchlines.

We have respect barriers along each pitch in which we expect parents and spectators to stand behind. Please do not stand anywhere else otherwise you will be asked to move. Remember the respect barrier is there for a reason.

The referee's decision is final on the field of play; please remember the code of conduct for managers, players and spectators, which should be adhered to for the whole tournament. The management decision is final and irreversible.
